APPEAL FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR ACTIVITIES IN THE AFFECTED AREA

Dear Donor,

Education standard in Batticaloa West (Battiwest) Educational Zone is currently well behind the rest of the country after the end of war. The teachers who come here from other parts of the country, tend not to stay here for long period of time, because this area is under developed, and lacking basic infrastructures. Therefore, there is always acute shortage of teachers. In this background, Oraayam Foundation, on the request of Battiwest Zone Educational office, has come up with an action plan under the following four categories. They are:

1. Providing financial assistance of Monthly allowance LKR 750 to Forty-six (46), Grade Six students who are from families living below poverty line.
2. Providing Tablet/Laptop to Five GCE Advance Level students from underprivileged families.
3. Appointment of Ten Volunteer Teaching Assistants to work at remotely located schools by providing them monthly allowance of LKR 2,000.
4. Providing Pen Drives to 719 Students from 26 Schools to facilitate the benefit of distance learning systems.

We need approximately a total of CAD 9,250, to implement the above projects. We could achieve this goal, when thirty seven benevolent donors individually or collectively contribute CAD 250 each. We earnestly request you to come forward and help these children to achieve their academic aspirations who are struggling with poverty.

A brief budget for these expenses, giving details and logistics is attached for your kind perusal. Further we hope to submit you the students' progress reports from time to time in consultation with the officials from the Education Department.
